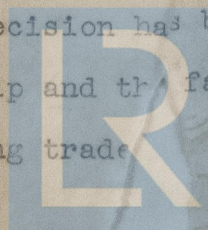

The Boiler Survey became due in June last year,
and no part of the survey has been held.

Action was deferred by the Classing Committee, the
vessel having been laid up at Nantes. On the 5th ultimo the
Nantes Surveyor wrote that the vessel had been sold to Italian
Owners, who were having her surveyed with a view to
classification with the Registro Italiano.

The Genoa Surveyors were requested to ascertain
the new Owners' intentions regarding the vessel's classific-
ation with this Society, and they replied that the Owners
had informed them that they would like, if possible, to
maintain the class, and they desired that the question of
classification might remain in abeyance whilst the vessel
made a voyage to Casablanca and back to Italy. Action was
accordingly again deferred, pending the receipt of further
information.

A letter has now been received from the Genoa
Surveyors stating that the vessel has again been sold, and
that the new Owners desire to withdraw this Society's
classification. A copy of a letter from the new Owners
confirming this decision is attached. The Surveyors add
that they understand this decision has been taken in view
of the small size of the ship and the fact that she will
only be used for the coasting trade.
