Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 8th instant, together with one from Mr. Cole, and also one from Messrs. The Lytham Shipbuilding & Engineering Co., with regard to the Tugs "ST. FAGAN", "ST. FAITH" and "ST. HILARY".

In reply thereto I have to inform you that the freeboard certificates for the "ST. HILARY" were sent to you on the 13th November, 1919, on receipt of the verification of marking form - see your letter of the 12th November.

The "ST. FAITH" was measured for freeboard assignment at this port in March last, and certificates were issued to the Master on the 21st of that month.

With regard to the "ST. FAGAN", no freeboard report has been received for this vessel, and if freeboard certificates are required, it is necessary for the ship to be measured and the usual freeboard report furnished.
