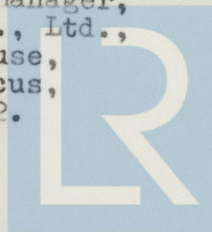
As to the last paragraph of your letter, no notification of cancellation of her British registry is required by this office as this is automatically passed to us by the Registrar General.
