the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd., attend their works at Renfrew, for the purpose of examining and testing two Water Wall Headers 8" square x 1" thick x 16'-7.9/16" overall length, manufactured by them under Contract No. 10/513 and intended for two boilers to be built by Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co. Ltd., for their Yard No. 1208.

The headers have been manufactured to approved plans under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors, and were found to be sound and free from defects. Mechanical tests of the material were witnessed by the Society's Surveyor at the works of The Chesterfield Tube Co. Ltd., where the headers were solid-drawn.

On completion of machining, the headers were examined, gauged and tested by hydraulic pressure to 795 pounds per square inch and found satisfactory.

For purposes of identification, each header was stamped A.J.B. adjacent to the Contract Number.
