ANSWER

According to information received in your office, this ship, which was involved in a collision in lower Elbe on 19th September, 1962, was refloated 30th September and beached for tightening. In reply to my letter of 27th September, 1962, the Finnish owners advised that as far as they are concerned, the loss is a total loss and they have referred the matter to the Underwriters. In these circumstances, I shall be glad if you will enquire and kindly advise me now whether any decision has been reached regarding her future.

It is understood that the vessel is now the property of the Wasserbauamt Kiel-Holtenuau, who advised us that she will be put up for auction at an early date and they will inform us as to the outcome of the auction.
