I have to acquaint you that the case of the Steamer "LEILA" received the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting today in consequence of a report from the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam of the survey carried out at Schiedam in April last.

In consequence of this inspection it has been decided to assign a provisional class of B.S\* (Reclassification Contemplated) in association with a notation of "Examined 4,51" and a docking date of "4,51 Sch."

The circumstances of this case are such that great difficulty has been experienced in assigning classification on account of the absence of the report of a survey carried out by the former British Corporation Non-Exclusive Surveyor at Helsingfors in August, 1949. Efforts to secure this document have unfortunately been unsuccessful and the present arrangement is an expedient which enables a provisional classification to be assigned on the understanding that this ship is submitted to a comprehensive survey by not later than June, 1952, allowing a full Special Survey notation to be assigned, thus permitting the ship to be shown as fully classed.
