S. I have to inform you that I am in receipt of a letter from Messrs. Fearnley & Eger, of your port, respecting their Motor Tanker "GARONNE", in which they enquire whether, owing to the fact that the vessel has only made one voyage of 2½ months' duration (after she was delivered by the Builders and has been laid up ever since), the Committee would be prepared to consider that the classification of the vessel might commence from the date at which she leaves your port, which was expected to be last Sunday or Monday.
