
M/T "GARONNE".

This vessel was built at Copenhagen by Messrs. Burmeister & Wain, and delivered from the ship building yard in the month of March 1931. She was taken home to Oslo and laid up until the 1st of December 1931. She made one voyage in ballast to San Pedro, Cal. and back to Hamburg with a cargo of clean oil. After being discharged she was taken home to Oslo and laid up on the 16th of February 1932 and she has been laid up ever since.-

She will now be chartered and sail from this port in a few days and as above stated she has been laid up practically the whole period of 2 years with the exception of 2 months and a half.-

In consideration of these facts we herewith apply for the vessel's Class Certificate to commence from the date that she leaves this port <sup>Say Sunday or Monday</sup> and we may inform you that the vessel has been thoroughly kept up in every respect as regards hull and engines.-

We are calling upon your representative in Oslo, Mr. Röli, to inspect the vessel in order to give you
