Ltd., Green Lane, Walsall, attend at their Works on the 5th November, 1947 and subsequent dates for the purpose of testing and inspecting the undernoted Cold Drawn Seamless Steel Tubes, made to the order of Messrs. Babcock & Wilcox Ltd., their order No. M.581 and intended for TSS TRESUS.

56 Tubes 2" o.d. x 100. x 11'2.1/4" long.
46 " 1.1/4" o.d. x 100. x 11'2.1/4" long.

Tensile, crushing, flattening and drifting tests were carried out with satisfactory results.

The tubes were examined and gauged and as far as could be ascertained were sound and free from defects. The ends of the tubes were not ground as normally required by Lloyd's Register.

Manufacturer's certificate of hydraulic test has been accepted for these tubes.
