I duly received your letter of the 24th instant in further reference to the proposed modification to Pumping Arrangements in the s.s. "HALLADALE", and have to inform you that the plan of pumping arrangement previously submitted has been further considered in conjunction with the additional information now furnished.

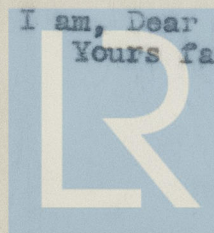
It is observed that the watertight floors at frames Nos.33 and 34 extend only to the side keelsons and that the sand tank bulkheads do not extend to the bottom of the vessel, and in the circumstances it is considered that the proposal of The Blyth Dry Docks & Shipbuilding Co. Ltd. to dispense with the additional bilge suction and sounding pipe previously recommended might be accepted.

The plan has now been amended accordingly, and is returned herewith.
