
The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

Nature of Survey

It is submitted before this case receives further consideration the Surveyors should be requested to forward a plan of the cargo doors if these are fitted in the shelter tween decks; they should also be requested to state whether the sheerstrake is doubled at the ends of the ~~bridge~~ ^{amidships} deckhouse as approved, whether the riveting of the poop and forecastle side plating is as required and whether cargo battens are fitted in the shelter tween decks.
