Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that Mr. Humphreys, the Superintendent for the Owners of the Steamer "MESA VERDE" has telephoned stating that this vessel will be submitted to full survey for classification of hull and machinery at Galveston, U.S.A. where she will arrive about the 22nd instant. At the same time, the shell and decks will be strapped and the additional reinforcements to bulkheads and bulkhead webs, bilge keel etc., fitted as indicated on the plans and specification prepared in this Office for this type of ship.

As the Owners will be unable to send one of their technical staff to Galveston to overlook this survey, Mr. Humphreys requests that the Society's Surveyors might be asked to give special attention to the case in the Owners' interests, so that the full survey and repairs may be satisfactorily and expeditiously completed.

Copies of the plans and specifications referred to above were forwarded to you on the 7th February last, and copies of the reports relating to the "MESA VERDE" are now enclosed for the information and guidance of the Surveyors concerned. I shall therefore be glad if you will make the necessary arrangements for the case to receive attention as desired by the Owners.
