I beg to acquaint you that the case of the Steamer "MESA VERDE" has now received consideration in view of the survey carried out at Glasgow in October/December last.

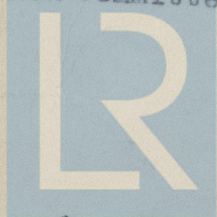
As a result of this inspection notations of 100A1 (Classification Contemplated) "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" have been assigned in association with a record of "Examined 12,47" valid for 12 months. A fresh docking date of 12,47 has also been assigned, subject to indented shell plating in way of Nos. 9 and 7 tanks (s.s.) and No. 3 (p.s.) being dealt with, and to 60 fathoms of chain cable being supplied.

I have to add that it is noted from the report that the Special Survey of the machinery has been commenced and Screwshaft Survey has been carried out. A record of 10,47 will accordingly be inserted in the Register Book in respect of the latter inspection.
