In reply to your Classing letter of the 29th September, 1959, we have to report that the owners have still not furnished us with any definite information, but it is understood that the ship is to be sold for scrap on her return from Northern Brazilian ports next month, and we shall give you confirmation of the position at the earliest possible moment.

The ships laid up at Santos, namely :- Sao Sebastiao, Sao Joaquim, Sao Pedro, and Sao Bernardo, are also being sold for scrap and will be broken up at Porto Alegre, in a matter of few weeks.
