I acknowledge receipt of your classing letter of the
27th December.

The forepeak and after peak tanks were stated to be
filled with fresh water which the Master was loath to discharge
as during the period the ship was under arrest difficulty was
experienced in obtaining fuel and fresh water and as the bulk-
heads were examined and found to remain tight it was decided
that an internal examination of these tanks might be dispensed
with on this occasion.
