As you are no doubt aware the above vessel has been placed under arrest at Lagos by the Nigerian Supreme Court on the application of a Swiss Bank. It is understood that a hearing has been arranged in that Court to commence on the 15th August next.

Mr. Petroutsis, the Owner, called at this office and has requested that extensions be granted in respect of the Special Survey, Load Line Certificate which expires on the 31st August 1962 and the Safety Equipment Certificate. A temporary Safety Equipment Certificate valid for two months which expires on the 5th September was issued by Mr. Guy. Mr. Petroutsis states that, as he anticipates that the vessel will be freed after the Court hearing, he desires the above mentioned extensions so that the vessel may proceed as it has a cargo of sugar for discharge at Takoradi and he wishes the vessel to continue to Triste so that any repairs necessary may be effected.
