Reverting to my letter of the 17th instant, in the absence of any definite information from you, the cases of the undermentioned ships have been submitted to the Committee today, who, in view of the fact that a survey is overdue in each instance have decided to record against the vessel's name in the Supplement to the Register Book a notation of "Class suspended - Survey overdue."

The cases in question are:-

I have been instructed to bring the cases up for review in three months' time if the overdue surveys have not been held, and it is considered the Committee will then decide finally to expunge class, unless satisfactory arrangements have been agreed in the meantime.

It will therefore be appreciated if you will let me know whether any arrangements are contemplated for the outstanding surveys to receive attention.

Since writing to you on the 17th September, reports of drydocking and tailshaft surveys have been received from the Society's Surveyor at Sourabaya in the cases of the Motorships "BIDO" and "BOGA", and accordingly the classes of these Tugs are being maintained.
