The class is subject to repairs to shell plate in way of E.R.(p.s.) at the Special Survey.

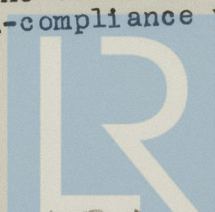
A SPECIAL SURVEY(C) became due 12,55. Postponement of Special Survey until 6,56 approved.

In a memo dated 15.8.56 the DJAKARTA Surveyor advises that this ship is still operating and has been issued with an extension certificate by the Harbour Master of Palembang. In view of this the Surveyor at Djakarta recommends the ship's class be expunged from the Society's Register Book.

IT IS ACCORDINGLY SUBMITTED for the consideration of the Committee whether the class of this ship be expunged on account of non-compliance with regulations.
