Dear Sir,

I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know whether the freeboard computation of Messrs. Nederlandsche Scheepsbouw My's Yard No. 236 would be affected in the event of a bent bridge and poop front bulkhead being fitted, so that the total length of the bridge and poop in the side would be 2060 mm. less than in the case of the sister vessel "ROTULA", (Amsterdam Freeboard Report No. 13397).

If the freeboards are increased through these alterations, I kindly request you to let me know the reduction in length in the side of bridge and poop which could be allowed with the same assignment of freeboards as for the m.s. "ROTULA".

A sketch of the alterations is herewith enclosed.
