The Downton Pump has been dispensed with but it is concluded that the owners are agreeable to fit same if required in the future.  
The Deep tank is arranged for the carriage of oil fuel as cargo and the owners have given an undertaking that the tank will be either full or empty when at sea.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed  100 A1 (Steel) Shelter Deck with freeboard," as recommended. The Summer freeboard of 2'-5 1/2" from centre of disc to top of statutory deck line at Upper deck, now marked on the vessel's sides, to be inserted in the classification certificate, and recorded in the Register Book, and further, the remaining freeboards, as shown on the accompanying verification form to be inserted in the certificate of classification.


