With reference to my letter of the 19th ultimo, I have now to inform you that part of the fees for survey during construction have already been collected but the following amounts would have been required had the vessels been completed in the U.K., namely:-

<u>"L.S.T.3004"</u>	
Hull	£112.
Machinery	£23.
<u>"L.S.T.3018"</u>	
Hull	£22..
Machinery	£11.

You will, of course, appreciate that these fees are only on a U.K. basis and should be increased in accordance with the usual practice for fees in Brazil, and in addition suitable fees should be charged for any major structural alterations carried out both as regards hull and machinery.

It is thought well to draw attention to the fact that the electrical equipment was not installed under Special Survey and the requirements of Notice No.1837 regarding plans and reports
