the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Two Water Tube Boilers Nos. 2235 made by Messrs. Connell Laird Ltd. of Birkenhead and erected and tested by The International Combustion Ltd. at Derby, to the order of Messrs. Iver Power Specialty Co. Ltd. Order No. R.P.C. 6505 and marked as below, have been surveyed during erection by the undersigned.

The material has been tested by the Society's Surveyors as required by the Rules; the scantlings are in accordance with the plans approved for a working pressure of 225 lbs. per square inch and workmanship is good. The Boilers have been tested in my presence on the 16th and 31st May, 1945, by hydraulic pressure to 337 lbs. per square inch, and were found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure.
