Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 22nd instant from which I am pleased to learn that you have been requested by your Principals in Batavia to transfer the Steamers "SINGKEP" and "BINTANG" to Lloyd's Register class on the next occasion they are in London. In connection therewith, the Committee will be pleased to deal with these cases in similar fashion to that already agreed upon for the Steamers "BENGKALIS", "SEMBILAN" and "SIMALOER" as set forth in my letter of the 1st February last.

It is also noted that they wish the Steamer "SAPAROEBA" to be similarly dealt with at Calcutta about the end of October next, and I may say that the necessary instructions in the matter are being sent to the Society's Surveyors at that Port.

It is also noted that you wish to discuss the possibilities of the transfer of the Passenger Vessels "JOHAN VAN OLDENBARNEVELT", "MARNIX VAN ST. ALDEGONDE" and "CHRISTIAAN HUYGENS", and in this connection I may say that a Representative from this Office will be at our Head Office in London on Monday next, the 28th instant, and will telephone you to make arrangements to that end.
