No. 83454 in Lloyd's Register Book 1940/41, on the 2nd day of June 1900 and fortyone and subsequent dates, while vessel was lying afloat at this port, in order to ascertain the fitness of the Lower hold and lower 'tweendeck Port --- deeptanks in Hatch No. 4 for receiving Palm oil in bulk as cargo and report as follows:

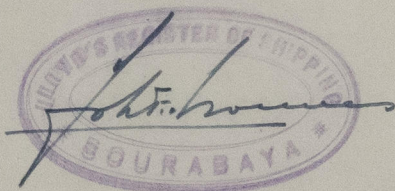
The lower hold and lower 'tweendeck port deeptanks in Hatch No. 4 have been tested by a head of water as required by the Rules and found sound and tight, double bottom tank under said deeptank tested with --- deeptank empty and found sound and tight. - - - - -

The bilge and ballast connections have been blanked off, and the heating coils fitted, tested and found sound and tight. - - - - -

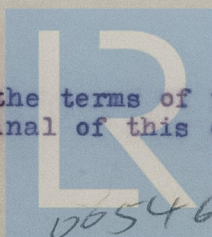
The above mentioned deeptanks have been finally examined on the --- sixth day of June this year, and were found clean, free of rust, --- paint, scale, residue and moisture, and fit for proper carriage of Palm oil in bulk to destination. - - - - -
