

Memorandum re Steam Trawlers managed by Mr.E.Bacon in connection with the cases for Classing Committee of the

S.S."INGOMAR"

S.S."LAPWING"

S.S."LEONORA"

The "LAPWING" & "LEONORA" belong to the Lindsey Steam Fishing Co.Ld., (Mr.E.Bacon Mgr.). In May 1905 the Owners' Superintendent informed the Surveyors at Grimsby that it was not the intention of the Company to submit their vessels to survey, but it was understood that the classes of the "LAPWING" & "LEONORA", which were then new vessels, would be retained.

The "INGOMAR" belongs to the Dolphin S.F.Co.⁷Ld. (Mr.E.Bacon Mgr.), together with three other vessels all classed viz;-

S.S."INGOMAR" built 1904-10
S.S."ORLANDO" built 1907-4
S.S."ORMONDE" built 1906-8
S.S."ORPHEUS" built 1905-7

Mr.E.Bacon is also Manager Owner for the Arctic S.F.Co.Ld.

On the 20th August 1903 the Owners informed the Grimsby Surveyors that the Company wished the classes of their vessels withdrawn, but later they stated that they wished four to retain their classes at least until the next surveys became due; the classes of these four vessels were withdrawn in October 1904 and May 1905.

The Company owns two other vessels still classed, viz;

S.S."VIDONIA" built 1907-5

S.S."VIOLA" built 1905-6
