Plan of After Peak Bulkhead.

I am in receipt of your letter of the 27th ultimo, enclosing a further communication from the Builders on the above subject. It is noted from the Builders' letter that this ship is now at sea, and it is not understood why this fact was not mentioned by you when submitting the plan of the After Peak Bulkhead.

The arrangements of the after peak as shewn on the plans forwarded have, however, been noted, and it is seen that a fresh water tank is fitted abaft the after peak bulkhead between the boiler flat level and the second deck. The tween deck stiffeners of bulkhead 8 should, therefore, be governed by Table 34 and be of the sizes as amended on the sketch previously forwarded. It will be observed that on bulkhead 4, forming the after boundary of this tank, the stiffeners are fitted of 6 x 3 x .42 bulb angles.

In the circumstances mentioned in the Builders' letter and having in view the fact that two deep wash plates are fitted in this tween deck tank, the stiffeners as fitted will be accepted in this instance.

You should see, however, that in future cases plans are submitted to this Office for consideration in adequate time, so that
