

In regard to the Assignment Letter of the 15th. instant respecting the new Freeboard for the steamer "BADJESTAN", we have inform you the conditions have now been carried out with one exception.

The freeing port area in the after well has again been checked, and there are five ports each 4'0" long x 1'6" wide. The area of these has been calculated to be 27.25 sq. ins.



We should be pleased to hear if it is necessary for an additional port to be cut.

The vessel is expected to sail on Wednesday next.
