In reply to your classing letter of the 12th instant regarding Report No. 11440 on the S.S. "DORSET COAST", in the absence of Mr. Gwynne I have made enquiries from the Builders and have to inform you that the thickness of the fore-castle deck is 15/16ths and the raised quarter deck is as required by the rules. Close ceiling  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " thick has been fitted on the inside of the frames at the side of the hold.
