Dear Sir,

In reply to your classing letter of the 12th instant regarding Report No. 11440 on the S.S. "DORSET COAST", in the absence of Mr. Gwynne I have made enquiries from the builders and have to inform you that the thickness of the forecassle deck is 15/16ths and the raised quarter deck is as required by the rules. Close ceiling $1\frac{1}{2}$ " thick has been fitted on the inside of the frames at the side of the hold.

The last paragraph of your letter will be dealt with by Mr. Gwynne on his return.
