
With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "ALBERT ZELCK", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel before them at their meeting today, and in view of no reply having been received from you to my enquiries of the 14th March and 19th July last, and no arrangements having been made to carry out the Boiler Survey, which became due so very long ago as February last, the Committee feel that they have no alternative but to expunge the vessel's class with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

The Committee desire me to add, at the same time, that immediately upon the vessel being submitted for the necessary survey, and upon receipt of a satisfactory report thereon from the Society's Surveyors, the vessel will be eligible to be recommended to the Committee for the re-instatement of her character.
