The Boiler Survey became due in February 1907.

Notices in regard to the survey were addressed to the Owners on the 14th March and 19th July last, to which no reply was received. Enquiries on the subject were addressed to the Hamburg Surveyors on the 11th September and 16th October, and from the reply received it appeared that they were unable to obtain a reply from the Owners.

On the 22nd October a letter was written to Messrs H.G.Harper & Co., the Owners' Agents in the City, asking what definite arrangements it was proposed to make with a view to the inspection being held. A further enquiry was made of Messrs.Harper & Co., on the 18th instant who stated that they were unable to obtain any reply to letters addressed to the Owners and they considered it useless for them to write further to the Owners on the subject.

The case was before the Classing Committee on the 19th instant, and it was decided to expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book with a red line (11.07), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
