Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 25th ultimo respecting the steamer "ILONA" and due note has been taken of the reply which you have now been able to obtain from the Owner's Representative at Athens.

It is observed that the vessel is at present laid up at Eleusis and that there is no intention yet of chartering her but that advice will be given in due course regarding the outstanding surveys.

This case has received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today and while action has been deferred as regards the 3rd Special Survey No. 1, in regard to which it is hoped some definite arrangement will be submitted for consideration in the near future, it must be distinctly understood that the Boiler Survey, which is now so long overdue, must be held without fail before the vessel is again placed in commission.

I shall be glad if you will inform me promptly should any fresh circumstances arise in regard to this vessel.
