With reference to my letter of
the 21st ultimo and previous corres-
pondence, I beg to inform you that,
having communicated again with the
Owner on the subject, I am informed
by him that the vessel is at present
laid up at Pireus and that some re-
pairs are being carried out on the
ship.

Representative in Greece that the
Society's Surveyor at Pireus has
been approached on the subject of
the Boiler Survey; but in all cases
he would suggest that the necessary
arrangements for the Boiler Survey
be made on the spot between his Re-
