With reference to my letter of the 21st ultimo and previous correspondence, I beg to inform you that, having communicated again with the Owner on the subject, I am informed by him that the vessel is at present laid up at Pireus and that some repairs are being carried out on the ship.

The Owner understands from his Representative in Greece that the Society's Surveyor at Pireus has been approached on the subject of the Boiler Survey; but in all cases he would suggest that the necessary arrangements for the Boiler Survey be made on the spot between his Representative and the Society's Surveyors.
