Motorship "SOLARIUM"

With reference to your letter of the 19th June, and previous correspondence, a report of survey carried out during July/August has been received from the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff, from which it is noted that a General Examination was carried out in drydock, the Continuous Survey of the oil engines completed, and the donkey boiler inspected.

As a result, the Committee have agreed to the postponement of the Special Survey until February next year, and have assigned fresh record of Docking Survey 7,57 Continuous Survey 8,57.


The class has been continued subject to the rudder being specially examined at the next drydocking, and to the propeller being examined and dealt with by that time. Further, the donkey boiler furnaces, which were found to be distorted, require to be examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of February next. When this has been done a fresh Donkey Boiler Survey record will be assigned.

I shall be glad if you will arrange accordingly.
