

(2) due to vessel being touched lightly on starboard bow by s.s. "Scribstan" whilst latter vessel manoeuvring in Roath Dock on 12.8.57.

recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and

that I have Recommended that she be retained as classed

with fresh record of Docking 7-57 subject (now) to rudder
