I duly received your letter of the 2nd which was submitted to the Committee on the 31st ultimo.

It was noted that you had received no replies to your last three communications to the Owners, and for your private information I would remark that as the Owners had requested withdrawal of class in their letter of the 8th October last, and bearing in mind that in accordance with the Committee's wartime practice they might have been prepared to agree to a request from the Owners for a General Examination to be held in lieu of the Special Survey which became due in April 1946, they did not feel the case fully warranted a Red Line.

The Committee therefore decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book and for (...) to be inserted in lieu thereof, and I cabled to you to this effect on the 31st ultimo. It is concluded you have informed the Owners of this decision.

It is thought well to add that your letter to the Owners on the 11th October explaining the position is concurred in.
