With reference to the request which we received on the 16th ultimo from Lloyd's Agents at this port to survey the Motorship "CABO SAN AGUSTIN", for damage, we beg to inform you that this vessel has been requisitioned by the Spanish Government and has left for Barcelona.

During her stay at Marseilles facilities were not afforded for a complete examination of damage in N°3 cargo tween decks stated to have been caused by fire at Buenos Ayres on the 30th July last and Lloyd's Agents were duly advised. We have also to add that nothing was done here towards the advancement or completion of the surveys referred to in your letter, "H", dated the 26th ultimo.
