Length 482.5 Breadth ESTRECHO 63.45, Depth 34.16 <sup>25.63 T-2M' DECK</sup> <sub>GROSS</sub> intended to be Classed T100 AL. WITH FREEBOARD. <sup>UPPER TOP OF CEILING TO TOP OF DECK AT CENTRE.</sup>

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
