With further reference to our letter of the 16th inst., regarding fees of the first entry surveys held on the above mentioned vessel, we think it as well to advise you, that so far as we know, these fees have not yet been paid.

As stated in the above mentioned letter we wrote to the builders on the 16th instant, stating that we understood that owing to the new Banking Regulations, that their Madrid Office were having some difficulties in obtaining sterling, and requested them to pay these fees in Bilbao as customary, in order that the classification certificates might be delivered without further delay.

They at once communicated with their Madrid Office, but they have not yet received any information whether the fees will be paid in sterling or pesetas, and they are again communicating with Madrid today.

In the event of the fees being paid in pesetas we shall be glad to know at what rate of exchange they should be charged.

We may add that it was our intention to charge at the

rate of exchange prevalent on the 29th September, the day on which our account was rendered in sterling, but we now understand that our friends at the Sdad. Española de Construcción Naval, Bilbao, expect to benefit from the rise of the pesetas and pay at the rate of exchange of the day when they hear from Madrid.

Under the above circumstances we shall therefore be glad to have your instructions, and to know if you intend to grant them this concession.
