This vessel was built at Bilbao and completed in September 1931.

The First Entry Reports were placed before the Classing Committee on the 6th October, and the vessel was classed *100A1 With Freeboard, Lloyd's A&CP, *LMC 9,31, O.G., Oil Eng.

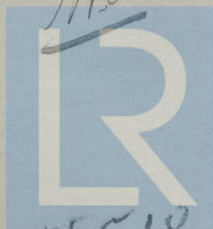
She appears in the Register Book with the record 100A1 With Freeboard, but the full classification has not yet (Class contemplated) been recorded on account of the non-payment of the fees for the special survey of the hull during construction and the fitting on board of the engines, and boilers, and electric light fee.

A cablegram has now been received from the Marseilles Surveyors reading as follows :-

"PLEASE CABLE PARTICULARS CLASSIFICATION FOR CERTIF"

It is submitted the Surveyors be informed as above and that therefore no Certificate F. can be issued.
