A letter has been received from the Builders stating that they have received the following accounts from the Society's Surveyors in respect of the survey for classification of this vessel :-

As this amount appeared to the Builders to be high, they requested Mr. Dykes to furnish an explanation, and he stated that the above amount included not only the fees and expenses in respect of this ship, but the expenses up to date of the second vessel building by them (Yard No.54) now nearing completion.

The builders object to this and consider that fees and expenses in respect of No.53/should be charged in this account, and that the fees and expenses for No.54 should be charged when that vessel is completed.

If this is not possible they suggest that the accounts for the Society's fees and expenses for both the vessels might be held over until the second vessel is completed.

The vessel has been building since 1930, but it would appear that the ship was not taken up by the original Owners but was left on the Builders' hands, and that they have since found a purchaser for her.

It is submitted that in the first instance Mr. Dykes might be informed of the Builders' letter and asked if their statements are correct, and, if so, to give his reason for including all the expenses to date for the two vessels in the account for the first vessel.
