Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the General Committee of this Society have had under consideration to-day your letter of the 6th instant with reference to the date of build to be recorded in the Society's Register Book of your new steamer "STAKESBY".

This vessel as you are probably aware was commenced in October, 1920 and launched in May, 1921.

In accordance with the Society's Rules in cases in which a vessel of a tonnage less than 7,000 tons gross is not completed with a period of six months from the date of her launch, the date of build is taken at a period of six months from that of the launching.

The date of build of the "STAKESBY" will accordingly be entered in the Register Book as November 1921, the extreme limit allowed by the Society's Rules in similar cases.
