Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 9th instant (not 9th May) regarding your First Entry Report No. 3066, it is thought well to call your attention to the fact that the last date of survey on your report of survey on the hull is 28th December last, and on the machinery 6th January, while your reports on the ship were not received in this Office until the 2nd instant, and that although your letter of the 27th April, received on the same date, mentions that the vessel lay at the Builders' Yard undergoing alterations which necessitated inspection, no reference to these alterations is made in your First Entry Report.

Further, the name of the ship is given in your report No. 3066 as "YORO MARU", whereas your letter of the 27th April refers to "the enclosed reports on the "CHERIBON MARU". I have therefore cabled you yesterday as follows, namely:-

"REFERENCE YOUR FIRST ENTRY THREENOUGHT DOUBLE
"SIX FORWARD REPORT FORM EIGHT FOR ALTERATIONS EFFECTED
"AFTER FIRST ENTRY REMOVED STATE WHETHER NAME YOROMARU
"OR CHERIBON MARU".

I shall be glad to receive also in due course a reply to the enquiries contained in the second paragraph of my letter of the 9th instant.
