

CASES OF STEAM TRAWLERS OWNED BY "TRAWLERS (WHITE SEA & GRIMSBY) LD."
(JAMES N. & H. BACON, MANAGERS) AND CLASSED IN THE SOCIETY'S REGISTER
BOOK.

The Grimsby Surveyors recently stated that it was the desire of the above Firm to discontinue the classification in the Register Book of the trawlers "CAPRICORNUS", "DELPHINUS", "DOURO", "IMPERIA", "LIBRA" and "SATURN", and, in the circumstances, the Classing Committee decided, on the 4th instant, to withdraw the classes of those vessels which were due for survey and to insert three dots (...) in lieu thereof, and they gave instructions that the classes of the remaining vessels should be dealt with in a similar manner as they became due for survey.

The Grimsby Surveyors now write that the Owners have intimated their desire to withdraw all their vessels from class, in order to save the survey fees.

A list giving particulars of the classed vessels (with the exception of the six cases mentioned above which have already been dealt with) which are now due for survey is attached, together with the case of one vessel which is not due for any survey at the present time.

same manner when a survey becomes
due.*
