Nature of Survey

The class of this vessel is subject to the inner surface of the bottom plating being examined in twelve months from the 15th August, 1921.

A proposal to defer the examination of the inner surface of the bottom plating for two months from the 11th December last was agreed to.

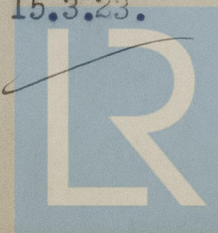
The London Surveyors now report vessel placed in dry dock, bottom and rudder cleaned and coated; and a number of rivets in the bottom renewed and the caulking overhauled, the ceiling lifted and the inner surface of the bottom plating examined and found in good order.

A few plates in the bottom were found to be set up, damaged through grounding, and the counter plating damaged, and the Surveyors recommend that the damaged plating be dealt with at the Owners' convenience, and the inner ^{Surface} service of the bottom plating be again examined before April, 1924.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey, subject as recommended.
