With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Tug "LARREA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had before them a report received from the Society's Surveyors at Buenos Aires from which it appears that some repairs have been effected on account of damage sustained through collision, etc.,

The Surveyors further report that the top gudgeon which was split has been repaired by means of the Oxy-Acetylene process, and in the circumstances, I am directed to say that the vessel's class has been allowed to remain subject to the top gudgeon being examined by the Society's Surveyors each time the vessel is placed in dry dock.
