Gentlemen,

I am in receipt of your telegram of today as follows:-

"LARREA and LAMPORT reports 23829 and 23902 complete  
"fees will be paid today certificates wanted per  
"return".

In compliance with your request I enclose herewith  
the first entry certificates for the steamer "LARREA",  
your report No. 23829.

Your message as regards the "LAMPORT" unfortunately  
came too late to admit of the certificates for this vessel to  
be forwarded today, but they will be sent by tomorrow's  
post.

I have to add that in any case where certificates  
of classification are likely to be wanted urgently it is  
desirable that the first entry reports should be forwarded  
with the least possible delay in order to admit of the  
preparation of the hull certificate.

With regard to this case I have to enquire the  
pressure to which the safety valves were adjusted; also  
whether easing gear has been fitted as these points are

I may remind you that similar information had to be requested from you on the 20th ultimo in regard to the steamer "LARREA".
