

Steam Trawler "NORMA MARIA".

The Special Survey No. 3 was held on this vessel in April. 1936. The Boiler and Screw Shaft Surveys became due 4.37.

In reply to enquiry regarding the ~~the~~ outstanding surveys the Amsterdam Surveyors forwarded a letter from the Owners stating that they desired to discontinue the class of the vessel on account of expense. The class was therefore withdrawn in September last.

A letter has now been received from the Amsterdam Surveyors in which they state that the Owners are considering the re-classification of this vessel with the Society, and they desire to know whether it would be sufficient if only the boiler and screw shaft surveys were held.

It is submitted for consideration whether, provided a general examination ^{of the hull} is held and favourably reported upon in addition to the Boiler and Screw Shaft Surveys, the vessel might be eligible to have her class reinstated in the Society's Register Book.
