We have received a communication from Messrs. N.V. Nationale Stoomvisschery of Ymuiden the Owners of the steam trawler "NORMA MARIA", no. 12174 in the R.R., intimating that they are considering the re-classification of this vessel with our Society.

We would refer to our letter H. of the 16th August and your classing letter dated 3rd September last, from which you will observe that this vessel's character was withdrawn from the Society's register book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof indicating withdrawal of class at Owners request.

In view of the fact that the special survey no.3 of the vessel was carried out at Hull in April 1936 the Owners would be very pleased to hear whether it will be sufficient for the re-instatement of the vessel's class to hold only the boiler and screwshaft surveys.
